


APPLICATION

Instructions: Read the story, then go back and reread the story and answer the questions.

Exodus 12:1-7, 12-13, 21-23, 28 NLT

The Bible says: ¹While the Israelites were still in the land of Egypt, the Lord gave the following instructions to Moses and Aaron: **(?1)** ³Announce to the whole community of Israel that on the tenth day of this month each family must choose a lamb or a young goat for a sacrifice, one animal for each household **(?2)** ... ⁶“Take special care of this chosen animal until the evening of the fourteenth day of this first month. Then the whole assembly of the community of Israel must slaughter their lamb or young goat at twilight. ⁷They are to take some of the blood and smear it on the sides and top of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the animal. **(?3)** ...

¹² On that night I will pass through the land of Egypt and strike down every firstborn son and firstborn male animal in the land of Egypt. **(?4)** I will execute judgment against all the gods of Egypt, for I am the Lord! ¹³ But **the blood on your doorposts will serve as a sign**, marking the houses where you are staying. *When I see the blood, I will pass over you. This plague of death will not touch you when I strike the land of Egypt.* **(?5)**

²¹ Then Moses called all the elders of Israel together and said to them, “Go, pick out a lamb or young goat for each of your families, and slaughter the Passover animal. ²² Drain the blood into a basin. Then take a bundle of hyssop branches and dip it into the blood. Brush the hyssop across the top and sides of the doorframes of your houses. And no one may go out through the door until morning. ²³ For the Lord will pass through the land to strike down the Egyptians. But **when he sees the blood on the top and sides of the doorframe, the Lord will pass over your home. He will not permit his death angel to enter your house and strike you down.**” ... ²⁸ So the people of Israel did just as the Lord had commanded through Moses and Aaron.

In the same way, Jesus is *our* Passover lamb. He died to pay for our sins; His blood that he shed on the cross covers us and saves us from death which is the price of our sins. **(?6)**
