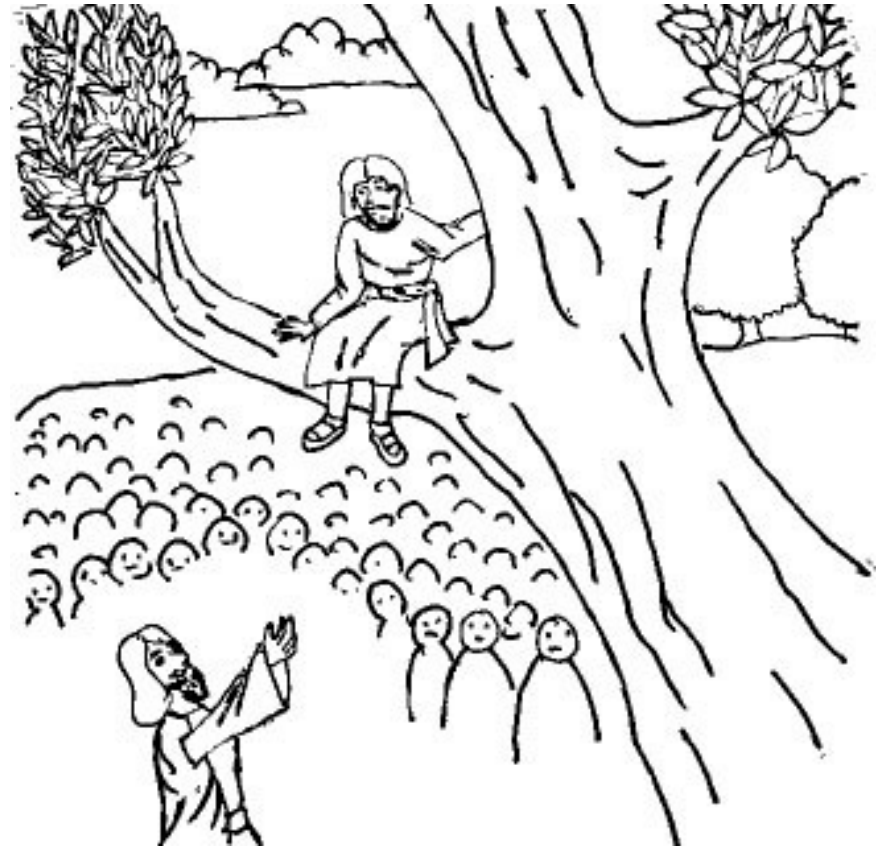

9 Jesus responded, Salvation has come to this home today, (?7) for this man has shown himself to be a son of Abraham. 10 And I, the Son of Man, have come to seek and save those like him who are lost." (?8)
