

4. Pray often.

The ... **BIG QUESTION** ... is:

WHO IS GOING TO BE THE BOSS OF YOUR LIFE?

YOU (that means your sinful nature is going to be your boss because you are shutting God out of your life)

YOUR FRIENDS (this means you are more concerned about pleasing sinful people around you than the God who created you, loves you and died for you.)

GOD who loves you, created you, knows the future, knows everything and has a wonderful plan for your life.

Often the next ... **BIG DIFFICULT THING** ... is:
TO WAIT FOR GOD'S PERFECT TIMING

Our God has a perfect timing for things. His will for our lives also includes His timing. If we love God and trust God, we will wait on Him and on his timing.

The Bible says: 25 *To whom will you compare me? Who is my equal?"asks the Holy One. 26 Look up into the heavens. Who created all the stars? He brings them out one after another, calling each by its name. And he counts them to see that none are lost or have strayed away. 27 O Israel, how can you say the LORD does not see your troubles? How can you say God refuses to hear your case? 28 Have you never heard or understood? Don't you know that the LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of all the earth? He never grows faint or weary. No one can measure the depths of his understanding. 29 He gives power to those who are tired and worn out; he offers strength to the weak.*

30 *Even youths will become exhausted, and young men will give up. 31 But those who wait on the LORD will find new strength. They will fly high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint. Isaiah 40:*

There are two stories in the Bible that teach this truth:

In I Kings, a man who had just become king ignored the advice of the older men who had served under Solomon and instead took the advice of his younger buddies. The result was that he lost most of his kingdom. Read it sometime in I Kings 12: 1-19.

In the book of Ruth, Ruth, a young Moabite widow, took the advice of her mother-in-law, and wound up with a wonderful man as her husband. Read about it in Ruth chapters 3 & 4, and especially Ruth 3:5.
