THE LORD'S PRAYER Matt 6: 9-11

Jesus taught his disciples to pray. As an example of prayer, or a model prayer, he said. ... ***Pray like this:***

A Prayer List

And don't let us yield to temptation, but deliver us
from the evil one.*

What to pray for

We should pray for “good things”

*your heavenly Father give(s) good gifts to those who
ask him.* *Matthew 7: 11*
